<b>Autumn</b>	In autumn, the weather begins to get colder. The leaves start to fall from the trees. The amount of daylight becomes less. This means the daytimes are shorter and the night times are longer
<b>Winter</b>	In winter, the weather is much colder. Sometimes it is cold enough to freeze, leaving frost and ice on the ground. It sometimes snows. Many trees have bare branches as all their leaves have fallen off.
<b>Spring</b>	In spring, the weather starts to get warmer. The leaves begin to grow on the trees and some trees may blossom. Plants begin to grow and you may see baby animals like lambs.
<b>Summer</b>	In summer, the weather gets hot. The daytime is long and the nights are short. The trees are full of leaves and there are lots of flowers, bees and other insects.
